The Family Care Center is currently assisting five families.

For the past three months, we could see God expanding our borders and opening new doors for ministry. We continue assistance to five families, while three other cases have been closed and referred to a supervisor for further support.



The Center works with families to help keep parents and children together.

Since our primary goal is preventing child abandonment, it is very important and joyful for us when a mother comes to us for help in restoring her children back to the family: We were supporting a mother and succeeded in getting back her three children, who had ended up in the orphanage because of a tragic turn of events. The orphanage's social educator and psychologist gave the mother a good conduct report, and gradually the woman was able to bring her children home. We provided them with clothing and food, and helped the family get to their home in a nearby village. We stay in touch with the mother and her supervisor also helps her.

This event was an Immanuel's Child Christmas puppet show with distribution of the gifts you helped provide. I invited a puppet group from Golgotha Church in Minsk. Brothers and sisters invited children from the city to the puppet show, and children from nearby churches were also invited.

At the appointed time, the House of Prayer was filled with children—46 in all. Some came for the first time. The great thing is that the children who were with us in Vacation Bible School during the summer responded to our invitation to come to Immanuel's Child. Included are two boys whose

parents are Catholics. Their mother is not opposed to sending their sons to our Sunday school, but the father has not yet made a decision.

The children enjoyed the Gospel puppet show. And not only the children were excited. One of the mothers said, "I thought that nothing would surprise me anymore, but here I was very pleasantly surprised." The program presented the news of the birth of Jesus Christ in a very interesting way through a wellthought-out plot. Beautiful scenery, good voice acting, and the expressive role-playing recitations delighted even many adults. After the children were presented with gifts consisting of fruits, sweets, and Christian literature.

Everyone enjoyed the Christmas program. After the end, I addressed the parents of the children with the Word of God. I told them that the birth of Jesus Christ is a great holiday, but there is also a sad connotation because the only begotten Son of God came into the world in order to die for the sins of all people, to give us salvation. Thus, both children and adults received spiritual food at this event.

ear faithful ministry partners, greetings from **D**Ukraine! I thank God for each of you every time I pray, and am so grateful to God for your dedication to the Lord, and for your spiritual and financial support of our ministry.

Our church is slowly growing and people are getting saved, and we praise God for that. Sometimes churches do not have baptisms of new believers for years, but we have been blessed to have held two baptism services in the past year. The first one was in the summer and five people were baptized. Then God called a few more people and in the last quarter of the year, we had another baptism service where two young people were baptized. We celebrated with another Baptist church in a nearby city. It is a great blessing to see how God is calling people to Himself!

I have one amazing testimony to share about one family who was strong in a nominal church in a new village we visited. The grandfather in this family even conducted the choir and is a major authority in this village. There are five children, and two of the girls heard the Gospel last year and were saved. They were baptized a few months ago. During the baptism service at the river, the whole family

came out to see what was going on and also heard the Gospel. God began His work, and another girl became saved and she was baptized last Sunday.

I also have some great news to share about media ministry. Last spring, I was able to contract with a new television station to air my evangelistic programs. We have the main program for 30 minutes twice a week, plus three minutes of short Gospel presentations every day before the local news. A few days ago, I had a meeting with the station management and we made a new contract to air 53 new programs and one repeat during 2022! This means a total of 106 messages will be on local

television and many people will hear the true Gospel! One unbelieving person took a picture of me on TV preaching the Gospel and sent it to me, telling me that God

Good News from the Caucasus!

Your gifts help faithful churches reach one of Russia's most difficult regions

greet you, dear brothers and sisters! We have been staying in this particular region of the Caucasus for seven months. We have been prayerfully trying to motivate believers from across Russia to come here and live, and to take part in advancing the Gospel. Our small team grows and it encourages us so much! Right now we have 10 adults and six children, with two families joining us very unexpectedly. God is preparing something in this place, bringing in new workers.

Many Roma people now attend our church. Some of them are believers and some are not. One of them comes forward every service to repent. I talked to them after the service and they told me that they

come forward to promise God to leave their former way of life, but they are very afraid that they might not be able to keep their promise. We realized then that we need to disciple them, and we invited them to our home for Bible study and fellowship. We have tea, study God's Word, and we're having a great time!

In a nearby neighboring region, our girls attended a gymnastics club that had been organized by a Muslim woman named Ralina. One day a new leader came, and we were told that Ralina had left the republic. To our great surprise, we met her back in our city where she had opened a gymnastics academy and our girls resumed their training. Our girls had told Ralina about their faith, and recently she asked them to come for training on Sunday. When our girls told her that they went to church on Sundays, Ralina began to ask questions about the church, and we then found out that she had two cousins in Tatarstan who had Baptist husbands. Ralina is the only Muslim in their family. In October, we celebrated "The Day of the Coach" and decided to give Ralina a copy of the Bible. We prayed and did not know if she would accept it. Later that evening, Ralina sent the girls a text message thanking them for the gift, and that she wanted to read it. Please pray for her as we build our relationship with her.

Please pray for our team, for unity and for wisdom from God on how to reach people. Pray for more faithful workers in our team. Pray for repentance among the Roma with whom we are ministering, and for the development of a home Bible study with them. We are thankful to you for your support and prayers. We are sure that the Lord sends out workers according to our prayers, and will continue His glorious work in our region. +

A recent Radio Free Europe report highlighted problems that orphans in Kazakhstan are facing as they leave the orphanage and have to find housing.

The law states that children raised in an orphanage have the right to state-funded housing when they grow up and leave the orphanage, but in practice many wait for decades to get their "permanent" home. The article said, "Some of them moved into a (temporary) dormitory as young couples and went on to have children and even grandchildren, yet still haven't received homes from the government. After a difficult start in life, man Kazakh orphans continue to struggle financially

Yet the challenges they face only spur them on to more prayer and an even greater determination to fulfill their calling from the Lord . . . *Go, therefore, and make disciples of all the nations* (Matthew 28:19).

I cannot overstate how important your prayers and support are for these faithful workers in God's Kingdom. In the reports they share with us and with their sponsors across North America, they continually express their thanksgiving, and tell us how encouraged they are to know that we are concerned for them, and have a passion for the Gospel work that they are doing.
